# The Ernest and Gisela Hale Scholarships for the Children of U.S. Special Operations Members in Cooperation with the National Navy SEAL Museum and the Unit Scholarship Fund (Army)

The Marlee Foundation, Inc. is a charitable 501(c)(3) organization that was established in late 2015 with the following charter:

- 1. To help those that cannot easily help themselves with the major focus being on children, veterans and animals.
- 2. To have 100% of administrative efforts covered by volunteers and donations from AJA International, Inc. only.
- 3. To have 100% of outside donations be used for the specific program requested by the donor.
- 4. To operate a fully transparent operation that ensures 1, 2 and 3 above are respected.

With a selfless heart and a tireless spirit, Marlee was my constant companion for over 14 years. She traveled the US with me and changed my life in many significant ways. To pursue these efforts in her name is very special to me and to all those that knew her.

Before formally establishing the Marlee Foundation, I began this scholarship program in early 2015 for the children of US Special Operations Members by working directly through the National Navy UDT SEAL Museum, its Executive Director, Rick Kaiser and Foundation Director, John Lee. Rick Kaiser immediately asked me to include Chairman Henry "Ike" Eisenbarth and the Army Unit Scholarship Fund into our new program. All these children that we have helped with over \$1,025,000.00 in scholarships to date have been truly phenomenal and deserving. The "Incognito Photo Contest" has made it even more special to myself and to our donors as we get a better insight into these creative, young individuals. Periodic updates from scholarship recipients are also welcome as it is very rewarding to observe these students striving to achieve their goals.

This program is dedicated to my parents, CWO-4 Ernest L. Hale and my mother Gisela W. Hale. Gisela grew up as a German civilian child during WWII surviving the Allied bombings and eating whatever her family could find to stay alive. After the war she went to work for the American military in a secretarial capacity. Everything she earned went to sending her older brother to university. When she married my father, CWO-4 Ernest L. Hale (veteran of WWII, Korea and Vietnam), she followed him around the world for his military tours and doggedly pursued her own higher education, eventually culminating in earning a PhD from Boston College. Both of my parents are now buried at Arlington National Cemetery. These scholarships are specifically for students pursuing careers in MILITARY SERVICE or EDUCATION.

I believe that offering a scholarship in their names is a fitting way to honor their dedication to serving one's country and to the pursuit of education against the odds. By making this funding available, we hope to say "Thank You" in a small way to those military families of Special Operations Members that have given so very much to us all.

Award Date: End of June 2025

A total of \$60,000 in EGHS Scholarships will be awarded in 2025. These awards will be checks mailed to the student but made out directly to the College or University. The funds are to be used exclusively for undergraduate tuition expenses for eligible recipients age 23 and younger. They are not to be used for books, room & board or subsequent redistribution to the student.

#### **Criteria for Awards:**

- 1. The awards will be based on:
  - a: prior academic, personal and community achievement
  - b: situation / application details / essay answers
  - c: financial need
- 2. In order to be considered for award selection, applicants are required to:
  - a: completely fill out the attached application form by hand and submit with the attachments requested
  - b: submit all other attachments requested in typed or printed format in order
  - c: submit "Incognito photo" by text to 775-379-5212

INDIVIDUALS WHO DO NOT COMPLETE THIS APPLICATION AS INSTRUCTED WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED

ALL APPLICATIONS WILL BE VETTED BY EITHER THE NAVY SEAL MUSEUM FOUNDATION or THE ARMY UNIT SCHOLARSHIP FUND and WILL BE KEPT STRICTLY CONFIDENTIAL.
